

ORDINANCE NO. 02/15/16(2016)

ORDINANCE ADOPTING AN AMENDMENT TO THE  
COMPREHENSIVE PLAN FOR THE TOWN OF FARMINGTON

The Town Board of The Town of Farmington, Waupaca County Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

**SECTION 1.** Pursuant to Section(s) 62.23/61.35/60.22(3) of the *Wisconsin Statutes*, the Town of Farmington is authorized to prepare and adopt a comprehensive plan as defined in Sections 66.1001(1)(a) and 66.1001(2) of the *Wisconsin Statutes*.

**SECTION 2.** The Town Board, by the enactment of an ordinance, formally adopted the document titled *Ordinance No. 08/07/(2007) An Ordinance to Adopt The Town of Farmington Year 2030 Comprehensive Plan on August 7, 2007*

**SECTION 3.** The Plan Commission, by a majority vote of the entire Commission at a meeting held on December 21, 2015, recommended to the Town Board the adoption of an amendment to change the land use designation of a parcel/parcels of land located at **E2239 King Rd., Parcel 05-36-31-13** from "Agriculture to Commercial" on the future land use map adopted as part of the comprehensive plan.

**SECTION 4.** The Town published or posted a Class 1 public notice and held a public hearing regarding the plan amendment.

**SECTION 5.** The Town Board of Farmington, Wisconsin hereby adopts the proposed plan amendment.

**SECTION 6.** The Town Clerk is directed to send a copy of this ordinance and the plan amendment to the parties listed in Section 66.1001(4)(b) of the *Wisconsin Statutes*.

**SECTION 7.** This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage by a majority vote of the full membership of the Town Board and publication or posting as required by law.


