ORDINANCE # 9

AN ORDINANCE TO CREATE SECTION 34 OF THE CODE OF GENERAL ORDINANCES ESTABLISHING A CODE FOR ONE AND TWO FAMILY DWELLINGS AND MANUFACTURED BUILDINGS FOR DWELLINGS BY ADOPTION OF WISCONSIN ADMINISTRATIVE CODE, CHAPTERS IND 20 THROUGH IND 25, THE UNIFORM DWELLING CODE.

The Town Board of the Town of Farmington, Waupaca County, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

Section 1

Section 34 of the Code of General Ordinances of the Town of Farmington is created to read as follows:

Section 34 Uniform Dwelling Code

- (1) The State of Wisconsin Administrative Code, Chapters Ind 20 through Ind 25 as adopted and effective October 8, 1980, and all amendments thereto, are hereby adopted and incorporated in this code by reference.
- (2) The Building Inspector, as certified by the Department of Industry, Labor and Human Relations and appointed by the Town Board, is hereby authorized to administer and enforce all of the provisions of the Wisconsin Uniform Dwelling Code.
- (3) Any existing ordinance pertaining to the construction of one and two family dwellings that conflict with the Uniform Dwelling Code and hereby repealed.
- (4) The Town Board shall hereby establish permit fees to cover the cost of administration, Plan review and building inspections.

Section 2

Any person, firm or corporation, in violation of any section of this ordinance, shall be subject to the penalties as provided in Section 29 of the Town of Farmington Building Code.

Section 3

This Ordinance shall take effect October 8, 1980, upon passage and publication.
