

ORDINANCE NO. 2-16 (1998)

TRESPASS TO THE DOG POUND: OTHER PROHIBITIONS

The Town Board of the Town of Farmington does ordain as follows:

Section 1. In this ordinance, "dog pound" means Stoney Acres Kennel and the lands on which it is situated or any other similar facility which the Town of Farmington contracts with, for enforcing and implementing the dog impoundment laws.

Section 2. It shall be unlawful for any person to enter the dog pound facility or kennel without the consent of the owners or some person lawfully upon the premises.

Section 3. It shall be unlawful for any person who enters upon the dog pound facility to refuse to leave said property when requested to do so by the owner, or a person in charge on behalf of the owner, of said property.

Section 4. It shall be unlawful for any person to take and carry away an impounded dog without the consent of the operators of the dog pound.

Section 5. It shall be unlawful for any person to abandon an animal or leave an animal at the dog pound without the permission of the dog pound operators.

Section 6. Penalty: Whoever violates this ordinance shall pay a forfeiture of not to exceed \$200.00 plus court costs. This ordinance shall be enforced by use of a citation

Section 7. This ordinance shall take effect the day after its publication.
