

RESOLUTION # 10-15-07(2007)A

WHEREAS, the **Town of Farmington Board** has adopted a comprehensive plan pursuant to Wisconsin Statutes s. 66.1001, and all zoning, subdivision, and official mapping decisions of the municipality must be consistent with the comprehensive plan per Wisconsin Statutes s. 66.1001(3); and

WHEREAS, changes to current ordinances are required to meet this consistency requirement, and further strategies are necessary to fully implement the plan that has been created by many citizens over the last four years; and

WHEREAS, the **Town of Farmington Board** acknowledges the Waupaca County Comprehensive Plan Core Planning Committee's desire to have all 34 municipalities participate in the *Intergovernmental Comprehensive Plan Implementation Project* generally described as Phases 1 – 7 of the attached "Waupaca County and Local Community Plan Implementation General Scope of Services"; and

WHEREAS, the **Town of Farmington Board** agrees the *Intergovernmental Comprehensive Plan Implementation Project* shall occur over a 3 year period to commence January 1, 2008 and end December 31, 2010; and

WHEREAS, the *Intergovernmental Comprehensive Plan Implementation Project* requires an annual financial contribution not to exceed 5% more than \$ 3,688.77 per the attached sheet from the Town of Farmington to be paid on or before February 1 of each year.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the **Town of Farmington Board** hereby agrees to participate in and help fund the *Intergovernmental Comprehensive Plan Implementation Project*.
