ORDINANCE NO. _____ (1998)

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING HUNTING -
PUBLIC ACCESS OFF OF NANCY LANE

The Town Board of Town of Farmington does hereby ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. The primary purpose of this ordinance is to further public health and safety based on the number of homes located in close proximity to the public access off of Nancy Lane, in the Town of Farmington. The public access is located at E2286 Nancy Lane.

SECTION 2. Definitions:

"Public Access" means the public access lane located at E2286 Nancy Lane, Town of Farmington, which provides access to an unnamed body of water.

"Dangerous Weapons" means any firearm, whether loaded or unloaded or any other device described in §939.22(10), Wis. Stats.

SECTION 3. No person may: (a) transport dangerous weapons across the public access; (b) hunt on the public access; or (c) possess or go armed with a dangerous weapon while on the public access.

SECTION 4. Posting. The Town Board shall post an appropriate notice advising the public of the prohibitions against hunting contained in this ordinance, in a conspicuous place on the public access.

SECTION 5. Any person convicted of violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be assessed a forfeiture not to exceed \$200.00, plus all applicable court fees and costs.

SECTION 6. This Ordinance shall take effect on and upon passage and publication according to law.
