

Ordinance 7-15-19 (2019)

**An Ordinance to Amend Ordinance 07-16-18(2018)Regulating the Parking of
Vehicles
On the Waupaca High School Parking Lot for Students**

The Town Board of the Town of Farmington does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1: Definitions: "Park or Parking" means the halting of a vehicle, whether occupied or not, except temporarily for the purpose of and while actually engaged in loading or unloading property or passengers.

Section 2: No Parking Where Prohibited by Waupaca High School Rules:
No person may leave or park any motor vehicle on private property (school grounds) without the consent of the owner or lessee of the property, as provided in s 346.55(3)(4) Wis Stats. School parking permit must be displayed in vehicle window. Student parking lot must be designated by signage.

Section 3: No parking in Areas Reserved for Physically Disabled. Except for a motor vehicle used by a physically disabled person as defined under 4 s. 346.503(10 Wis. Stats, no person may park, stop or leave standing any vehicle, whether attended or unattended and whether temporarily or otherwise, upon any portion of the Waupaca High School student parking lot, any official signs and markings, for vehicles displaying special registration plates issued by the Department of Transportation or vehicles registered in another jurisdiction and displaying a registration plate issued by the other jurisdiction which designates the vehicle as a vehicle used by a physically disabled person.


Section 4: Penalties: Any person violating this ordinance shall be required to forfeit \$20.00 plus costs. This ordinance shall be enforced by the Waupaca High School safety liaison officer or designee.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication according to law.


