

**Resolution 6/21/21(2021)**

**Adopting the Waupaca County All Hazards Mitigation Plan**

**Fiscal Impact:** None

**WHEREAS;** the Town of Farmington recognizes the threat that natural hazards poses to people and property, and

**WHEREAS;** undertaking hazard mitigation actions before disasters occur will reduce the potential for harm to people and property and save tax payer dollars, and

**WHEREAS;** the Town of Farmington participated jointly in the planning process with the County and local units of government within the County to prepare an All Hazards Mitigation Plan, and notice of the completed plan was published indicating the All Hazards Mitigation Plan is available for review and will be kept permanently in the Waupaca County Emergency Management Office.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** that the Town Board of the Town of Farmington adopts the Waupaca County All Hazards Mitigation Plan as an official plan, and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,** that the Waupaca County Emergency Management Department will submit, on behalf of the Town, the adopted All Hazards Mitigation Plan to Wisconsin Emergency Management and Federal Emergency Management Agency officials for final review and approval. Minor changes made upon advice from Wisconsin Emergency Management and Federal Emergency Management Agency will not require re-adopting this resolution.
