

RESOLUTION 09/19/05A(2005)

**A RESOLUTION CHANGING THE POLLING LOCATION
OF WARDS 3, 4 & 5**

WHEREAS, as of January 1, 2006 there will be Statewide Voter Registration in Wisconsin; and

WHEREAS, the Federal Government has mandated that HAVA (Help Americans Vote Act) which requires each polling place to have ADA electronic voting equipment at each polling place by January 1, 2006; and

WHEREAS, the Clerk of the Town of Farmington is a self provider of this Statewide Voter Registration System; and

WHEREAS, to insure the most efficient and accurate conduction of an election process, and to better serve the needs of the electorate, it will require that all Town of Farmington Wards (1, 2, 3, 4, 5 & 6) will now be voting at the Farmington Town Hall between the hours of 8:00 A.M and 8:00 P.M.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS: The Town of Farmington shall have one Polling Place, located at the corner of State Road 54 and County Road Q, at which all elections will be held between the hours of 8:00 A.M and 8:00 P.M. The Clerk will co-ordinate with Wisconsin Veterans Home to assure that Veterans will be able to vote absentee on a designated day prior to each election or will be mailed an absentee ballot.

BE FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Clerk forward a copy of this resolution to the State Elections Board and Waupaca County Clerk.
